Nathaniel, husband of Sarah, died Aug 1799 [CR2 Congregational Church says 1 July 1797 age 50].

Nathaniel married **Sarah BLANCHARD** 9 Dec 1773 in Portsmouth, Rockingham, NH. Sarah was born about 1755 in , , NH and died about 1820 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME.

Sarah m2 Ruben Knowlton 20 Nov 1799 in Belfast. No death or cemetery record found. A Sarah E Knowlton d 28 Dec 1835, buried in GR 13, South Belfast Cem. An Ancestry tree says she d 1820, no source. There are Blanchards in early Belfast - possible relations. Nathaniel's mother remarried Orlando Bagley of Kingston NH; perhaps Sarah was from there.

Belfast Marriages says John Thurston, ref CR2 Belfast Congregational church which they likely went to even if they lived in Belmont. There are other potential 2nd marriages for him in Belfast VR.

There is also a John Thurston in Belmont [History of Belmont], who was a petitioner of the founding of Greene Plt in 1813.

1810 Greene Plt census: John Thurston 2M <10, 1 M 26-45; 2 F <10, 1 F 26-45 [correct ages]

1820 Belmont census: John Thurston 3M <10, 2M 10-16, 1 26-45; 1 F <10, 2 F 10-16, 1 26-45 [correct ages]. No further record in Belmont.

June 10, 2014 email from Peter Smith: "John appears on the 1810 and 1820 census of Belmont, Maine. He then buys land in Palmyra, Maine in 1822 and sells the land in 1828 and then relocates to Newport, Maine where he died August 1849. His wife, Elizabeth appears on land deeds relinquishing her dower rights until 1848, when John signs by himself.

John Thurston and Elizabeth French are both myself and Nancy Battick's ancestors."

The question is to prove which John/Jonathan Thurston that Elizabeth French married.

Elizabeth married **John THURSTON** 20 Feb 1803 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME. John was born about 1780 and died in Aug 1849 in Newport, Penobscot, ME.

24 M iv. **Jacob FRENCH** was born about 1782.

Belfast mar int 26 Apr 1809, Jacob French & Ruth Toothacer of Islesborough [likely in Islesborough, but not recorded.]

1810 Belfast census: Jacob French 1 M 26-45, 1 F <10. [?? Did Ruth die in childbirth?]

Jacob married **Ruth TOOTHAKER** in Apr 1809 in Belfast, Waldo, ME. Ruth was born about 1790.

25 F v. **Rebeckah FRENCH** was born about 1783.

26 F vi. **Sarah FRENCH** was born about 1785 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME and died 4 Apr 1862 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.

Belfast Deaths: a Sally Wilson, dropsy, Apr 4 1862, a 77. [Sarah, Apr 3, CR3- Methodist Episcopal Church] Not found 1850. 1860 Belfast 740/827 is Sally Wilson 75 b ME; 740/828 is L E Bisbee 22 & Eliza 26, Laura 1.

Marriage rec says Swanzey Wilson, elsewhere seen as Swazey. Not in an Ancestry census index, but 1900 Topsham has a Swanzey G Wilson Jan 1879, nephew of William J Wilson Feb 1853 M21 ME-3 & Amelia A Apr 1850 NB-3.

Sarah married **Swanzey WILSON** 7 May 1821 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME.

Belfast VR: Jesse Husy & Jane French, Dec 10 1818. Not found in 1820-1830 census.  
Jane married **Jessey HUSSY** 10 Dec 1818 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME.

**21. Eliphalet FRENCH** (*Nathaniel<sup>4</sup>, Eliphalet<sup>3</sup>, Edward<sup>2</sup>, Joseph<sup>1</sup>*) was born 6 Mar 1775 in Salisbury, Essex, MA and died in Mar 1850 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.

Belfast VR & Belfast Congregational Church has birth dates of Levina, Charlotte, Nathaniel, and Phebe. Also has the mar int of Eliphalet and Abigail Edds, recorded between July 14 and Sept 26 1802. Marriage date recorded of Eliphalet & Mrs Thankful Howard 4 July 1826 (her first marriage not recorded there). "Thankful d ae 96 in Northport."

1810 Belfast census: 1 M <10, 1 M 10-15, 1 M 26-44, 3 F <10, 1 F 26-44.

1820 Belfast census: 2 M <10, 1 M 10-15, 1 M 45+, 1 F 10-15, 1 F 16-25, 1 F 26-44, 1 person in agriculture.

1830 Belfast census: 1 M 15-19, 1 M 20-29, 1 M 50-59, 1 F 15-19, 1 F 40-49.

Eliphalet French sold land in Belfast 1842, 1848, 1849.

The will of Eliphalet French was written 20 Aug 1849 in Belfast when he was very weak and feeble. It was presented in April 1850. Children mentioned are Charlotte, Phebe, and spouses Howes and Hardy.

The unidentified son b 1812 was killed by falling from the rigging of the Schooner Bunker Hill on Dec 1, 1826 at about age 14 [same as Benjamin?]. Not all ch in census are accounted for.

Eliphalet married **Abigail EDES** in 1802 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME. Abigail was born about 1780 and died 28 Aug 1825 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME.

Children from this marriage were:

Eliphalet next married **Thankful** [MRS HOWARD] 4 Jul 1826 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME. Thankful was born in 1783 and died 19 Dec 1874 in Northport, Waldo, ME.

**22. Abraham FRENCH** (*Nathaniel<sup>4</sup>, Eliphalet<sup>3</sup>, Edward<sup>2</sup>, Joseph<sup>1</sup>*) was born in 1777 in Salisbury, Essex, MA and died about 1845 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.

Belfast VR has the mar int of Abraham French & Susanna Thomas 4 Feb 1810. Dau Sarah is buried in Grove Cem in sister Nancy's lot. age 22y 5m.

1810 Belfast, right after Eliphalet: just Abraham & Susanna, both 26-44.

1820 Belfast, Hancock census: 1 M <10, 1 M 26-44, 2 F <10, 1 F 16-25, 1 F 26-44, 1 person in agriculture.

1830 Belfast census: 1 M 5-9, 1 M 15-19, 1 M 50-59, 1 F <5, 1 F 40-49.

Abraham & Eliphalet French bought land in 1816, 36-262.

Abraham and wife sold land in Belfast Apr 1845 to Benjamin Brown, part of Lot 33 1st div, 5+/- acres, lately the dower of widow Sarah French. Susanna French sold land to Benjamin Brown 1849, her dower land, Lot 33 in 1st Div, 65-414.

Abraham married **Susanna THOMAS** in Feb 1810 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME. Susanna was born in 1787 and died 13 Jan 1862 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.

Priscilla Jones and Roland Rhoades had tried for many years to determine Susanna's ancestry, to no avail. Ancestry of Susanna unk, but VR lists other Thomas marriage ints from Lincolntonville; possible siblings Huldah m1808, Abigail m1809, Betsey m 1812, Mary m1821. Belfast VR has a Benjamin Thomas who died in Belfast Nov 1830 age 58 (= b 1772, possibly a brother of Susanna). Other Thomas's in Lincolntonville that could be siblings.

Belfast Republican Journal death notices:

28 Nov 1839 issue: Nathaniel French, in this town, age 52.

14 Nov 1833 issue: Mary French (nee Thomas) in this town, wife of Nathaniel aged 32.

21 Nov 1833 issue: Mary French in this town, wife of Nathaniel, aged 34 [correction of age?]

1830 Belfast census: Nathaniel 1 M 5-9, 1 M 40-49, 2 F <5, 1 F 5-9, 1 F 30-39.

Nathaniel French sold land in Belfast to Amasa Patterson 1835, 19-454.

This Nathaniel French instead of the one b 1806, seems to be the one who married Joanna Day Hallowell in 1838 Belfast. Timing is right with him seeming to die shortly after.

Nathaniel married **Mary THOMAS** 17 Mar 1822 in Belfast, Waldo, ME. Mary was born in 1799 and died in Nov 1833 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.

The child from this marriage was:

- 40 U i. **Child FRENCH** was born in 1822 in Belfast, Waldo, ME and died 8 Aug 1825 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.

Nathaniel next married **Joanna DAY** in Jun 1838 in Belfast, Waldo, ME. Joanna was born about 1810 in , , ME and died after 1850.

Joanna Day of Windsor md 1 Hiram Hallowell of China, int 1 Jan 1828; m2 Nathaniel French, Cert iss 6 June 1838 Belfast.

Belfast VR v2 p159: "Nathaniel French & Joanna Hollaway, int [rec between July 11 and Aug 15, 1835.

Nathaniel French & Joanna Day, int Sept 20, 1837, Certificate issued June 6th 1838." Joanna's son John Hiram (Hiram J) married Nancy French, dau of Nathaniel's brother Abraham.

Marston/Knight Ancestry tree says she d 18 Oct 1898 in Fryeburg; this is a Joan (Abbott) Day; definitely the wrong person.

Hiram's brother John married Elizabeth/Eliza Day whose parents and grandparents are identified, and it is possible that they are sisters, though there is no record of Joanna's parents.

1840 Belfast census shows a Widow J D French: Males: 1 5-10, 1 10-15; Females: 2 5-10, 1 30-40 [correct age].

The Nathaniel French b 1787 instead of the one b 1806, is the one who married Joanna Day Hallowell in 1838 Belfast. Timing is right with him seeming to die shortly after.

See Belfast Marriages p159: Mrs Joanna E French had 3 other possible marriages 1840, 1842, and 1843. 1840 int; 1842 int "revoked by Mrs J E French"; 1843 was mar int to Samuel Parker of Augusta and a cert was issued June 3. Any trace in 1850 census? 1850 Augusta census shows a Samuel Parker 68 at the Poor Farm; ditto age 75 in 1860; no Joanna.

Belfast VR has mar int date of 10 July 1808, and birthdate of son James, both spelled Guptel. Lemuel Guptill m2 Mrs Betsey Thomas, 28 Aug 1859 Belfast. Nancy died of dropsy age 80.

1810 Belfast, Hancock census: 1 M <10, 1 M 26-44, 1 F 16-25.

1820 Swanville, Hancock census: 2 M <10, 1 M 10-15, 1 M 26-44, 2 F <10, 1 F 10-15, 1 F 26-44, 1 person in agriculture.

1830 Swanville, Waldo census: 2 M 15-19, 1 M 20-29, 1 M 40-49, 1 F 40-49.

1840 Belfast census: 1 M 50-59, 1 F 50-59, 1 person in agriculture.

1850 Belfast census recorded as Samuel Guptil 65 farmer b MA, Nancy 61 ME, Lemuel 13.

1860 unviewable on Ancestry.

1870 Belfast census Wd 5 78/86: Lemuel is 84 b ME in household of Edwin Spear 34 & Lucy L 38. and other Guptills.

Lemuel was the son of Stephen Guptill 1744- & Sarah Barnes 1747-1836. Some info from Ancestry trees, which has much more.

Nancy married **Lemuel GUPTILL**, son of **Stephen GUBTAIL** and **Sarah BARNES**, in Jul 1808 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME. Lemuel was born in 1784 in Berwick, York, ME and died 24 Dec 1877 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.

Levina married **Alexander WILSON** 3 Dec 1819 in Belfast, Hancock (now Waldo), ME. Alexander was born in 1791 in , ME and died after 1850.

Charlotte married **Hiram HOWES** 17 Sep 1829 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.

He was considered something of a genius, and had invented several articles, some of them having been sold for a good sum. He leaves a wife, a small son, a daughter by a former marriage, and one brother, John Rhoades of this town. His age was 45 years. Funeral services were held at his home at 10 o'clock Wednesday forenoon, Rev F.S. Walker officiating. Interment was made at the village cemetery."

Roland and son Ivan are both buried in Pittsfield Village Cemetery, but it appears there is no stone and no record and that the cemetery buried someone else on top of him. Daughter Irma in Pittsfield tried resolving the question with no luck in the 1950s. Rev Frederick S Walker was a Universalist minister, at Pittsfield Universalist 1908-1915, and later at Waterville 1925-1928. Roland and his family worked in textile shops in his early years. Roland's first patent for which we find a record was filed Jan 9 1891 when Roland was age 24 and granted Jan 26 1892. It was for an improvement upon the loom.

Roland Eaton Rhoades was named after Roland L Eaton (1835-1870), son of the Rhoades family's good friends and cousins by marriage, Joseph Eaton (1800-1865) and Mary A (1809-1868). The Eatons are all in Fort Hill Cemetery in Winslow.

April 1910 Belfast Ward 2 census lists Roland E Rhodes 41 div rents at 71 1/2 High St and is a jeweler, repair work, working on own account. Not found 1900.

Roland was named after Thomas Edison because his father had worked with and thought highly of him.
