No death rec found for either in RI, NH, or VT records on Ancestry. Helen Harris says the Harris heritage is mysterious and nobody would talk about it, just that the name was changed.

Frank married **Kate HOFFMAN**. Kate was born in 1825 in NY and died after 1896 in RI.

2. **Frank Theodore HARRIS** (*Frank Theodore*¹) was born on 2 Nov 1860 in Providence, Providence, RI and died on 17 Dec 1923 in Lancaster, Coos, NH.

Comments from Helen Harris age 91 in 2005, and other info: Frank Harris was big, blond, and good looking, says gda Helen Harris. There is a photo of him sitting in the yard holding a baby grandson Frank, with Helen and Viola. The kids really liked their step-grandmother Nora. Frank had brothers William, Fred, and Albert. William was 44 and single in the 1920 Lunenburg VT census with his brother Frank. Frank was a dairy farm owner; William a herdsman. Uncle Bill once gave Helen Harris a doll, the only time she remembers seeing him. William was "big and okay-looking". Fred had a jewelry store in Providence and gave his brother or nephew items, incl a tiepin. Fred also had a son in jail. Albert nfi. Susan Hamel says 1/10: "My mother remembers one of Frank's brothers who lived with him who was limited, maybe slow or some form of autism, but he insisted on wearing his winter coat in both summer and winter." Jan 2010: Helen left Groveton at about age 7 and remembers that 'slow' person as being Frank's other son Ray. They always played in that barn where Frank died. The bullet ended up going through a stovepipe and the kids would look at the bullet holes. Barn was torn down years ago. Ray was about a foot shorter than Roy. Roy had dark hair and Frank and Ray had blondish hair.

Frank's death cert gives his exact b and d dates, b in Providence RI. He was a farmer and died of a self-inflicted gunshot wound, dying 36 hours later; contributing cause despondency. Correspondent Susan Hamel in Jan 2010 says "Frank had the reputation of being the nicest, most even tempered man, but he shot himself within hours of hearing that he had skin cancer even though he had no symptoms other than the visible spot on his face." Buried Summer St Cemetery, Lancaster. Cemetery lot "Lot 2 Div 2", 5th left after driving in, down at the end on rt, was bought by Lenora in 1923. Big granite Harris stone with small in-ground flat stones for Frank T 1860-1923, Lenora 1875-1948, and Roy T 1889-1927. Don't know where wife Helen is buried; check with Tom Covell in Town Hall 636-1460. Roy Edward Harris' b/c [a 1953 certified copy anyway] says he was b 24 June 1886 in Groveton Village, Northumberland NH, as the SIXTH child of Frank Harris 31 laborer b Providence RI & Helen Bucknam Harris 31 b Northumberland, rep by C C O'Brion MD Groveton.

A disintegrating scrap of paper, looking like a school paper, found 2009 in a wallet believed to belong to Frank Harris, son of Roy, which reads "Frank Harris That large oak tree was planted by my grandfather. [D]avid caught a mouse in the trap. gran.....is ...rink....the... [could be something about my grandmother's trunk?]" Also in the wallet was a 1969 calendar and a m/v Mt Washington trip around Lake Winnepesaukee Souvenir Ticket, inside a money gift card reading "Mother, Love +Kisses, Viola + Don ". Also a Series 1935B \$1 bill with a 1946 Royal Bank of Ireland stamp on it with handwriting on it: "Elizabeth Oakes, Mount Pleasant, _ _ingalk , Or? South".

Marriage cert for Frank Harris, 38, hotel keeper, b Providence RI and Lenora Blodgett, 21, "table girl", b Guildhall VT, both of Northumberland NH, were m in Groveton 31 Dec 1895 by James Curtis, JP. Cert states his parents were Frank Harris not living b Providence RI, and Kate Hoffman of Providence age 70 housewife b CT. Lenora's parents were James Riley Blodgett 40 and mother's name Lestina Rena Grow age 45, both of Northumberland. Lestina b 14 Nov 1849 in Bridgewater VT, d 7 Feb 1905 in Guildhall; James b 30 Jan 1853 in Northumberland, d 1 Nov 1924 in Guildhall. Rena L Grow is age 1 in 1850 Bridgewater VT census, dau of Benjamin F 41 & Fanny Grow 40.

Frank married **Helen M BUCKNAM**, daughter of **Edward Franklin BUCKNAM** and **Emeline H BURBANK**, on 23 Jun 1880 in Pawtucket, Providence, RI. Helen was born on 30 Jul 1854 in Northumberland, Coos, NH and died on 3 Oct 1895 in Northumberland, Coos, NH.

Marriage notice found in Helen Harris' files (evidently a Lynn paper): Popular Employee of Printery Marries Recruiting Officer. A wedding which is of interest to many young people in this city, was solemnized yesterday afternoon at the Washington St. Baptist Church parsonage on Richmond street when Roy Edward Harris of Lancaster was united in marriage to Miss Hilda Oakes. The ceremony took place at 4:30 and the Rev A E Kenyon was the officiating pastor. The bride was attended by Mrs Frances Qualey and Mrs L E Williams and in addition to several invited guests, Mrs Harris's Sunday School class was in attendance. The groom was formerly recruiting officer for the United States Army and Navy when the office was located in this city. He won many friends during his residence in this city who will extend congratulations on the event of this auspicious occasion. The bride until recently was employed in the folding room of the printery and was very popular with her associates. When she concluded her labors last Wednesday she was presented with a beautiful silverset and a complete outfit of table linen as a token of the esteem in which she was held by them and as a suitable remembrance for her wedding. The bride is a native of New Albany, Nova Scotia, and a part of the honeymoon will be spent there. Mr and Mrs Harris left on the 6:20 train for Boston last night and from there they will later go by boat to New Albany.

Roy Harris had dark hair and eyes acc to his WWI registration.

Roy and wife Hilda are buried in Belleville Cemetery, Newburyport.

1920 Groveton, Northumberland Town, Coos NH p 231: Roy E Harris, renter, M age 33, b NH-RI-NH, salesman retail grocery; Oakes H wife 30 immigrated 1910 naturalized; Helen L dau 5 b MA; Viola P dau 3 b NH; Frank O son 1 b NH.

1930 Newburyport MA census, 133 Storey Ave: Roy E Harris 43 rents \$20. NH-RI-NH salesman, meat and groceries; Hilda E 40, Helen E 15, Viola P 12, Frank T 11, Kathleen 5.

They also lived on North Main St in Lancaster. Roy didn't go to church and Hilda was a Baptist. A neighbor offered to bring the kids to the Newburyport Congregational Church with her and that is how they became Congregationalists. Roy was a butcher, so the family had meat during the WWII shortages. Hilda is a Generation 10 descendant of Mayflower passenger Richard Warren, and a Generation 11 descendant of Mayflower passengers John Howland & Elizabeth Tilley.

Obituary

Roy E Harris 60, a well known meat cutter here for many years, died in his sleep last evening following a short illness.

Mr Harris, and employee of the A&P Company more than 20 years, had been manager of the meat department since it opened. He was born in Northumberland NH, son of Frank and Helen (Bucknam) Harris, and came to this city 23 years ago.

He leaves a wife, Hilda (Oakes) Harris; a son Frank O Harris; three daughters, Mrs Bradford Swap of west Newbury, Miss Helen L Harris and Miss Kathleen Harris, both of this city, and a stepmother, Mrs Lenora L Harris.

Mr Harris was a member of the regular Army for nine years previous to World War I.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday afternoon at 3:30 at the late residence, 19 Ferry road. Friends may call at the Elliott Funeral Home, 35 Green St, Friday evening from 7 to 9.

A family heirloom is a very nice old rocking chair that Helen told us was made from maple trees on the Oakes family farm in New Albany, probably by Charles Oakes in the late 1800s. Helen re-visited the family farm with a friend at one point (1970s?) and the new owners showed her through the whole house. We also have a porcelain plate on which somebody painted a picture of the whole farm which we will use as a guide when we go visiting to Nova Scotia; it is located on the main road that goes through town.

He was a veteran of WWII, serving in Europe in the US Army, and a member of Caleb Butler Lodge A.F.&A.M. (Freemasons) of Ayer, and active in the Boy Scouts. He was survived by sons from his first marriage, Donald J Hall of Minneapolis MN, Peter B Hall of Norfolk VA, dau Mrs Donna Krays of Adelphi MD, 2 brothers Charles H & William A Hall both of Newburyport, and 5 grandchildren .

There has been speculation that John was the estranged son of William Bucknam of Charlestown, MA. This is disproved by the request to the courts which was filed on June 6, 1695 by William's daughter-in-law Judith requesting subsistence for the tending of her deceased husband's brother John, who had been living with them for 20 years. (Evidently, this John was abducted by his grandmother shortly after his mother's death, raised by her and in 1672, while living at Rehoboth MA, was a partner in a silver mine at Providence RI. Around 1678 he was "struck dumb" and didn't regain his speech until 1696). Gravesend (Long Island, NY) was divided in 1645 into thirty-nine lots and among those receiving shares were: Richard Stout, John Buckman, Samuel Spicer, Nicholas Stillwell, John Bowne, William Goulding, William Compton, and others whose names are familiar in the early history of Monmouth. The following year, 1646, John Buckman sold his share to Thomas Applegate, who was probably the same Thomas Applegate who, with the colony of Massachusetts Bay in 1635, was licensed to keep a ferry between Weymouth and Braintree.

John Buckman's will, dated 20 April 1681, was allowed 28 July 1681(Suffolk Co. Probate #1183): In the name of God Amen I John Buckman of Boston in New England Senior being in a Competant measure of health and of a Sound Memory and under understanding yet Considering the frailty of mans life... Doo make and ordaine this to be my last will and testament revoking and Nulling all other willes by me formerly made In manner following First I Bequeath my Soule unto the Everlasting armes of Jesus Christ my Saviour hoping through his grace to obtain Everlasting life when this miserable life is Ended And my body to the Earth from whence it came.. Item I give and Bequeath my Just debts and funeral expenses first being discharged unto my two children Mary Buckman and Jeremiah Buckman all the Estate I shall leave behind mee at the time of my decease Equally to be divided between them. Only I give unto my Daughter Mary my best furniture besides the said halfe part & a Chest and Drawers belonging to it and I doo make and constitute my lovinge friends Mr. John Viall Junior and Samuell Townsend to be the Executors and overseers of this my last will desiring them to take care that this last will may be performed and that my two children above named may have what I leave behind mee at my decease when they come to age. And In testimony that this is my last will I have hereunto Set my hand & Seale this twentieth day of April 1 -Anno Dm one Thousand Sixe hundred & Eightyand one. 1681. [Samuel Townsend renounced his Executor ship and Thomas Kemble deposed that he and Nicholas Shepley were present at the signing of the will (Case #1183, Recorded. July 20, 1681).]

An inventory of John's estate was performed on May 13, 1681 and consisted of: no real estate; 2 ruggs (00 16 00); 3 shirtes, 3 shoohes, 3 shawls (01 05 00); a parcell of his wearing clothes (01 0000); one old chest of drawers (00 10 00); a meale trough, 2 ironpotts & potthookes tongs & gridiron (00 10 00); one bed, bedstand, 2 pillows, 1 old rugge & some other ould bedding (02 00 00); one ould cubberd (00 05 00); two pewter dishes, 3 earthen dishes & 1 pan (0004 00); one wooden spinning wheele and cards (00 04 00): Total: £0614s 00d. On September 24, 1684 the widow of John Buckman was granted his entire estate since he made no provision for her in his will.

HENRY LUNT

ORIGIN: Unknown (but see *COMMENTS* below).

MIGRATION: 1634 on the *Mary & John* (on 26 March 1634, "Henry Lunt" was enrolled at Southampton as a passenger for New England on the *Mary & John* [Drake Founders 71]).

FIRST RESIDENCE: Ipswich.

REMOVES: Newbury 1635.

CHURCH MEMBERSHIP: Admission to Newbury church prior to 2 May 1638 implied by freemanship.

FREEMAN: 2 May 1638 (fifth in a sequence of five Newbury men) [MBCR 1:374].

EDUCATION: Henry Lunt signed his deeds and his wife signed by mark. His inventory included "books" valued at 12s. [EPR 1:395].

OFFICES: Ipswich grand jury, 27 September 1653, 29 September 1657, 25 September 1660 [EQC 1:289, 2:51, 225]. Arbitrator, 9 April 1657 [EQC 2:41].

His inventory included "arms" valued at 50s. [EPR 1:395].

ESTATE: On 3 November 1657, "Henry Lunt of Newbury with Ann my wife" exchanged land with "Tristram Coffin of of the above said town," Lunt receiving "eight acres of upland in the South Field" and Coffin receiving "four acres & three quarters of arable land in the Little Field" [ILR 4:323].

In his will, dated 8 July 1662 and proved 30 September 1662, "Henry Lunt of Newbery" bequeathed to "Ann my wife during her natural life my dwelling house, barn, orchard, with the pasture ground the houses stands in, with my ground joining to the pasture, as also eight acres in the Little Field, as also my meadow in the marshes on this side Plum Island River"; to "my son Daniell all the corn ground & pasture ground, which was formerly Thomas Doves, as also my marsh ground at Plum Island"; "my son Daniell shall give to my daughter Presilla twenty pounds" at age twenty-one or marriage; to "my daughters Sarah, Mary & Elizabeth to each of them twenty pounds"; to "my son John twenty pounds & to my son Henry five pounds"; "after my wife decease I give unto my son John & to my son Henry my dwelling house, barn, orchard [gap] the land it stands on with my ground joining to the pasture, as also eight acres in the Little Field, as also my meadow in the marshes on this side Plum Island River (except that at Jerreco as they call it) to each of them an equal portion"; "my son John & my son Henry after my wife decease shall pay unto my daughters Sarah, Presilla, Mary & Elizabeth to each of them ten pounds"; to "my son Daniell after my wife decease the meadow or marsh ground at Jerreco"; "Ann my wife [to be] the sole executrix"; "Anthony Mo[rse] Senior & Abraham Toppa Senior to be the overseers"; "if my daughter Pr[e]silla die before the age of twenty-one years or of marriage that then the twenty pounds be divided amongst here brothers & sisters equally"; "my wife Ann shall have liberty of three cows pasturing in my son Daniell pasture as long as she liveth" [EPR 1:393-95].

The inventory of the estate of Henry Lunt, taken 5 August 1662, totalled of which the real estate totalled "lands & housing," [EPR 1:395].

On 20 March 1664[5?], "Henry Luntt of Newbury and Anne my wife" sold to "William Pillsbury of the town aforesaid all that parcel of land containing by estimation sixteen acres in Newbury"; signed by Joseph Hills and Ann

Hills; "Ann Hills acknowledged her free consent to this deed the 11th of April 1667" [ELR 13:93]. (Note that this deed was dated more than two years after the death of Henry Lunt, yet he is given as one of the grantors. The date of the deed was twelve days after the marriage of Henry widow to Joseph Hills, indicating that this instrument confirmed in writing a transfer made years earlier by Lunt to Pillsbury.)

On 14 May 1685, whereas "Henry Lunt of Newbury deceased did by his last will & testament leave his wife Ann Lunt now Ann Hills his executrix to convey, enjoy & possess an house & certain lands in Newbury aforesaid during her natural life & whereas the said house & lands after her decease were bequeathed to John Lunt & Henry Lunt the sons of the said Henry Lunt deceased in reversion and whereas said John Lunt being deceased left his widow Mary Lunt which might possibly claim her right in the said reversion, we the said Ann Hills, Henry Lunt & Mary Lunt now Mary Nelson" sold to "Lawrence Hart of Newbury one half acre of land lying in Newbury" [ELR 15:312].

(In 1963 Walter Goodwin Davis presented information suggesting, but not proving to his full satisfaction, that the immigrant Henry Lunt was the same as the Henry Lunt, son of Thomas Lunt, baptized at South Marston, Wiltshire, on 21 December 1610 [Abel Lunt Anc 3-4].)

COMMENTS: There is no record supporting Henry Lunt residence in Ipswich in 1634, but we assume that he, along with many of the founders of Newbury, spent the winter of 1634-5 in Ipswich prior to moving to their new plantation. In 1654 Henry Lunt was one of the many inhabitants of Newbury and other towns who signed a petition in support of Lt. Robert Pike, who had earlier been censured by the General Court for remarks defamatory of the government [MBCR 3:345; EQC 1:366]. The General Court appointed commissioners to interrogate the petitioners. Henry Lunt was one of three men who said only that "they intended no affront to the court" [EQC 1:367].

BIBLIOGRAPHIC NOTE: In 1963 Walter Goodwin Davis prepared an account of the families of the immigrant Henry Lunt, of his three sons and of other descendants in the male line [Abel Lunt Anc 3-41].
