### First Generation

1. **Henry RHODES**, son of **Walter RHODES** and **Elizabeth Joanna BARSTOW**, was born in 1608 in Lancashire County, England and died in 1703 in Lynn, Essex, MA.

Note: I currently list here only the basic line bringing the Rhoades Family to Winslow, Maine. Most early settlers were buried in the Old Western Burial Grounds, at the foot of Lynn Common.

Henry married **Elizabeth COLDHAM**, daughter of **Thomas COLDHAM** and **Unknown**, about 1639. Elizabeth was born in 1618 and died on 25 Nov 1700 in Lynn, Essex, MA.

The child from this marriage was:

2 M i. **Josiah RHODES** was born in Apr 1651 in Lynn, Essex, MA and died on 23 May 1734 in Lynn, Essex, MA.

TEG May 1995 p92: Samuel moved to New Marlborough in 1778. In 1777, at a town meeting of Walpole, Samuel Rhodes, his wife and all their children were warned out of the town of Walpole. He was a private in Capt Ebenezer Cox's Co from Stoughtonham in the French & Indian Wars {Rhodes typescript at NEHGS p83}. Children are not in order.

Samuel married **Abigail THORP**, daughter of **James THORP** and **Elizabeth THORP**, on 18 Jul 1749 in Stoughton, Norfolk, MA. Abigail was born about 1728.

5. **Stephen RHODES** (*Eleazer Jr<sup>3</sup>, Josiah<sup>2</sup>, Henry<sup>1</sup>*) was born on 1 Feb 1716/17 in Lynn, Essex, MA and died on 23 Jan 1792 in Stoughtonham, Norfolk, MA.

Stephen married **Deliverance WALCOTT**, daughter of **William WALCOTT** and **Unknown**, on 25 Oct 1740 in Stoughton, Norfolk, MA (Int). Deliverance was born on 15 Nov 1724 in Attleboro, Bristol, MA and died on 11 Sep 1804.

Children from this marriage were:

Stephen married **Mary BOYDEN** on 18 Jan 1764. Mary was born on 11 May 1744 in Walpole, Norfolk, MA.

6. **Solomon RHODES** (*Samuel*<sup>4</sup>, *Eleazer Jr*<sup>3</sup>, *Josiah*<sup>2</sup>, *Henry*<sup>1</sup>) was born about 1750 in Dedham, Norfolk, MA and died in 1806 in Deering, Hillsborough, NH.

In July and September of 1984, I published in *The Maine Genealogist* [then *The Maine Seine*] a genealogy in progress of the Winslow Maine branch of the Rhoades family. I mentioned in that article that I was stuck on Rufus Rhoads, born 1787 NH according to the census, who married Abigail Reynolds in Winslow 21 March 1811. I was unable to find Rufus in any NH or MA records. For 14 years, I had nothing new to report, but finally in 1998 stumbled upon the identity of a number of Rhoades families who moved to Maine. Here are some notes that made me look for other names in my search beyond Rufus Rhoades. June 1809: Reuben Rhoads of Vassalboro bought land from John Myrick - 100 acres at 15 Mile Stream (now Carrabasset Stream in Clinton). July 27, 1811: Reuben Rhoades, yeoman, of an unincorporated place, 25 Mile Pond (now Burnham), sold to Rufus Rhoades of Winslow land in Bridges Town (now Troy), lot 6 of 7th range, 100 acres, for \$300. It is land that Reuben now lives on. [This may have been a mortgage.] I'm not sure what land(s) this is, but it created a tie between Reuben and Rufus. Researching Reuben in the census and VR, I discovered that he was only a little older than Rufus and born in MA. I thought possibly a brother. I likewise believed further clues may be other Rhoades who passed through Winslow, such as Levi Rhoades and Chester Rhoades, both of whom are briefly mentioned in Winslow VR, and then moved to Gardiner. I'd still like to identify Michael Rhoades of nearby Chelsea, Hallowell, and Augusta. The other four are indeed brothers, in the sixth generation of the Henry Rhodes of Lynn, MA branch. [There are also two other unrelated branches of Rhodes in Maine - the Kittery/Eliot branch and the Germans of the Waldoboro area.] I would like to thank Marcia Wiswall Lindberg of the Essex (County MA) Society of Genealogists, who provided the vital clues I needed in her four part series of descendants of Henry Rhodes of Lynn, Essex, MA (born 1608) in *The Essex Genealogist* in 1994 and 1995. She said she had no more information on Solomon than what she published. It was five years later (looking for Rhoades's to help someone else! It pays to answer queries!) that I re-read her article and noticed at the very end in the May 1995 issue, she lists the children of Samuel Rhodes<sup>4</sup> (Eleazer,<sup>3</sup> Josiah,<sup>2</sup> Henry<sup>1</sup>) and has a subparagraph on the children of Samuel's son Solomon<sup>5</sup>. I quote that paragraph from page 92: Notice especially the sketchy info on children 1, 4, 8, and 11. viii. SOLOMON RHOADS, b. at Dedham, d. at Hillsborough, Hillsborough, NH 1806; m at Dedham, MA, Oct 1781, ELEANOR RHOADES-5, b. in 1761 [Stephen<sup>4</sup>, Eleazer<sup>3</sup>, Josiah<sup>2</sup>, Henry<sup>1</sup>]. Solomon was a Revolutionary War soldier; went to Rhode Island in 1778. Children: 1. Reuben. 2. Solomon, b New Marlborough, 30 Nov 1783; died Antrim, Hillsborough, NH 1850; m 1807 Mary (Polly) Fairbanks. 3. Eleanor. 4. Rufus. 5. James, b at Pelham MA 31 May 1789; d there Oct 1795. 6. Silas, b at Pelham 8 Mar 1791; d Jan 1880; m1) 26 Nov 1815 Rebecca Hayward; m2) Laura C Ballou. 7. Amos, b at Pelham 16 Sept 1792; d there 15 Apr 1794. 8. Levi, b there 6 Sept 1794. 9. Abigail, b there 3 May 1802; d 27 Feb 1803. 14. Lucinda. 15. Harriet; m at Cambridge, Middlesex, MA [not found in VR]. We have here much circumstantial evidence, but I found more. We have these 4 settlers of the Winslow area all mentioned in this family. Their various name spellings evolved into Rhoades. Census says Rufus of Winslow was b 1787, which fits in perfectly at two years before child #5. Chesterfield's [Chester] birth date here from Pelham MA VR is matched exactly in the VR of West Gardiner, ME. Levi Rhoades died 11 Nov 1872 in Gardiner, Kennebec, ME at age 78, which would make him born in 1794. Reuben is 77 in the 1860 Troy, Waldo, ME census, placing his birth date at 1782, which fits right in. Rufus Rhoads married Abigail Reynolds. Researching the Reynolds line, I had come across what is now another piece of evidence, but which I never before recognized as a clue to my Rhoades line. Abigail's brother Leavitt Reynolds was born 4 April 1796 in Hillsborough, NH. The Reynolds family moved to Vassalboro and Winslow. So, both families made a brief stay in Hillsborough, NH between their MA and Maine residences. I have sorted through some vital records to sort out some of their descendants and would appreciate hearing from anyone with more information. [If the town is listed after the date, my source is the printed Vital Records to 1892, or VR on microfilm after 1892.] Other ref: Solomon was a soldier in the Rev War. His widow Eleanor applied for a bounty land pension in 1856 at the age of 95. It has names and letters from many other Rhoades cousins. It is available on Heritage Quest. Not sure of whether land was granted. Correspondent and cousin Kerry Jackson Sept 2010, says Solomon died in 1806 after being thrown by his horse and hitting his head on a rock.

If you have his brother's pension requests (Samuel and David's) also, you'll read that his younger brother James T. Rhoades testified that Solomon was the oldest of ten children of Samuel Rhoades and Abigail Thorpe of Dedham.

Solomon married **Eleanor RHOADES**, daughter of **Stephen RHODES** and **Deliverance WALCOTT**, on 26 Oct 1781 in Dedham, Norfolk, MA. Eleanor was born in 1761 in MA and died between 1856 and 1859 in Alexandria, Grafton, NH.

Solomon had no children. "History of Antrim, Hillsborough, NH 1744-1877" by Rev W R Cochrane 1880. 1850 Antrim census shows Mary Rhoades 63 b MA and a Martha Fairbanks age 84 b MA [likely her mother].  
Solomon married **Mary FAIRBANKS** in 1807 in Antrim, Hillsborough, NH. Mary was born in 1787 in MA and died after 1860 in Antrim, Hillsborough, NH.

- F xii. **Betsey RHOADES** was born on 11 Apr 1801 in Pelham, Hampshire, MA and died on 16 Jul 1801 in Pelham, Hampshire, MA.
- F xiii. **Abigail RHOADES** was born on 3 May 1802 in Pelham, Hampshire, MA and died on 27 Feb 1803 in Pelham, Hampshire, MA.

This Harriet who "married unk and moved to Cambridge, Middlesex, MA" may really be Harriet, daughter of Solomon's son Silas, who married Hezekiah Gale and res Cambridge, Middlesex, MA. Only source I've seen is History of Antrim, Hillsborough, NH.  
Harriet married **UNK** in Cambridge, Middlesex, MA.

Eleanor married **Solomon RHODES**, son of **Samuel RHODES** and **Abigail THORP**, on 26 Oct 1781 in Dedham, Norfolk, MA. Solomon was born about 1750 in Dedham, Norfolk, MA and died in 1806 in Deering, Hillsborough, NH.

**8. Reuben RHOADES** (*Solomon*<sup>5</sup>, *Samuel*<sup>4</sup>, *Eleazer Jr*<sup>3</sup>, *Josiah*<sup>2</sup>, *Henry*<sup>1</sup>) was born in Jun 1782 in MA and died on 2 Dec 1864 in Troy, Waldo, ME.

1860 Troy Census has Reuben age 77 & Hannah age 73 living with son Albion and family-says (Albion) is 40yrs. so prob. is (Alvin) as listed in Troy VR as being born in 1820. Census says Reuben born in Mass, and Hannah in NH. See "Troy Maine Past & Present 1793, 1827-1977" by Mitchell. Troy was originally called 25-mile Pond Plantation in 1795, then Bridgetown, inc as Kingville 1812, became Joy 1814, Montgomery in 1825, and Troy in 1827. Troy's peak population was 1484 in 1850. Troy VR - 1880 Mortality census says

Hannah was NH-3, resident 64 years (1815), in Alvin's household, "cancerous humor". 1790 Londonderry NH census has a John Steele, 3-3-4 = 3 males over 16, 3M under 16, 4 females. Marriage date is from published Londonderry VR book.

Reuben married **Hannah STEELE** in Feb 1807 in Londonderry, Rockingham, NH. Hannah was born in Aug 1786 in Londonderry, Rockingham, NH and died on 3 Dec 1879 in Troy, Waldo, ME.

Children from this marriage were:

- 13 F i. **Lucy RHOADES** was born on 7 Jun 1807 in Derry, Rockingham, NH and died on 20 Apr 1838 in Troy, Waldo, ME.

- 15 F iii. **Harriet RHOADES** was born on 3 May 1812 in Troy, Waldo, ME and died on 9 Aug 1898 in Troy, Waldo, ME.
- 16 M iv. **Otis RHOADES** was born on 27 Apr 1814 in Troy, Waldo, ME and died on 13 Mar 1885 in Kenduskeag, Penobscot, ME.
- M v. **Reuben RHOADES** was born on 18 Apr 1816 in Troy, Waldo, ME and died on 3 Feb 1817 in Troy, Waldo, ME.
- 17 F vi. **Maria/Marcie RHOADES** was born on 16 Dec 1817 in Troy, Waldo, ME.
- 18 M vii. **Alvin RHOADES** was born on 18 May 1820 in Troy, Waldo, ME and died on 3 Apr 1891 in Troy, Waldo, ME.
- 19 F viii. **Syntha/Cyntha RHOADES** was born on 17 Oct 1822 in Troy, Waldo, ME and died on 4 Dec 1846 in Troy, Waldo, ME.

**9. Rufus RHOADES** (*Solomon*<sup>5</sup>, *Samuel*<sup>4</sup>, *Eleazer Jr*<sup>3</sup>, *Josiah*<sup>2</sup>, *Henry*<sup>1</sup>) was born in 1787 in Pelham, Hampshire, MA and died on 9 Jan 1873 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME.

1850 Winslow census Rufus Rhoads age 62 b ME, Abigail age 60 MA.

1860 Winslow census Benfus Rhoades age 72 b NH Farmhand pers estate \$75, Abigail 69 b Maine. Indexed as Benfus and looks like Benfus, but I believe it was re-transcribed from the originals which said Rufus not Benfus. Delete Benfur/Benfus as a middle name.

1870 Winslow Rufus Rhoades age 84 b NH. Death record age abt 87.

Rufus served in The War of 1812 with the Winslow Army unit. Adna Reynolds also served with this same unit. His occupation was a farmer, which he pursued until he was 84 years old. At that time he was living with son Snell Rhoades and his wife Harriet. We are not sure where he and Abigail are buried, but there are two "empty" lots right next to his son John and his wife Nancy in Fort Hill Cemetery, Winslow. Since John died before his father, perhaps the money saved for Rufus and Abigail's stone went for his son's stone instead, and no one else had the means or interest in providing stones for this first generation in Maine.

"The Eastern Mail" paper of Waterville Maine ran an article "Talk About Winslow" in its April 22, 1864 issue about the early settlers of Winslow (when Rufus Rhoades was still alive). I found a transcript at the Taconnett Genealogy Library in Winslow. Selected quotes include from Page 44: "These farms are stony and harder to till than any other except that owned by Col. Britton. .... Rufus Rhoades formerly owned the farm now owned by Col. Britton. ... R. Rhoades [came] from Pelham, NH". We know that the Rhoades family came from Pelham Mass to NH when Rufus was a child [History of Antrim, Hillsborough, NH]. Rufus told census enumerators that he was born in NH. Perhaps he really was born in Pelham Mass and only remembered NH from his childhood and confused the right town with the wrong state when he talked with this reporter. Hillsborough and Antrim, Hillsborough, NH (see Solomon's story) border each other; Pelham NH is a long ways away on the Mass border, and no where near Pelham MA. My guess is that Rufus was born in Pelham MA like the children born before and after him, and that they later moved to NH.

Rufus married **Abigail Thayer REYNOLDS**, daughter of **Thomas REYNOLDS** and **Tabitha THAYER**, on 21 Mar 1811 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME. Abigail was born on 2 Jun 1790 in Bridgewater, Plymouth, MA and died on 1 Jun 1869 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME.

Abigail Reynolds is a double descendant of Mayflower Pilgrim Edward Doty. This Mayflower connection is documented in the Mayflower Society's Edward Doty silver books through both Edward Doty's son John and daughter Mary. The connections are Edward Doty1, John2, Elizabeth3, Elizabeth Morse4, and Betty Turner5; and also Edward1, Mary2, Hannah Hatch3, Japhet Turner4, and then

Betty<sup>5</sup> again; Thomas Reynolds<sup>6</sup>, and Abigail Reynolds<sup>7</sup>. Also descended from Stephen Hopkins and Francis Cooke. Contact Roland Rhoades for my Mayflower application worksheets if you'd also like to be a documented Mayflower descendant. Abigail's middle name is based on second hand oral history.

James' parents were Samuel Warren & Ruth Sherman. Adopted Child of ELENOR RHOADES and JAMES WARREN is: REBECCA NASH LORING, b. 21 August 1839, Norridgewock, Somerset, Maine; Records indicate that her parents were Charles Loring and Elizabeth Emerson. Also, the Warrens were listed as her adopted parents.  
Elenor married **James Jordan WARREN** on 24 Mar 1836 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME. James was born on 4 Jul 1808 in Islesboro, Waldo, ME and died in 1891 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME.
- 22 M iv. **John Bryant RHOADES** was born on 27 Sep 1819 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME and died on 29 Apr 1869 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME.
- 23 M v. **Rufus Snell RHOADES** was born on 6 Nov 1822 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME and died on 29 Jan 1897 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME.

At the NERGC 2009 conference, I looked at and immediately bought the new book VR of Stoughton MA to 1850 by David Allen Lambert 2008. John and Nancy's marriage date had been missing after nearly 30 years of searching. For some reason, they had come back to MA to marry, even though both were born and lived in central Maine. The index shows other Rhoades and Reynolds cousins in town there, and also fills in some

blanks for previous generations. They were married by Isaac Smith, Pastor of the Baptist Society in East Stoughton, "both parties from Stoughton". John B Rhoades died April 29, 1869, leaving a personal estate worth \$1000 and real estate worth \$2000. His land is described as about 100 acres bounded on the west by the Seabasticook River, south by land of John B Stratton, north by Chales C Stratton and Charles E Warren, and east by L. Bangs. Left 7 minor children in 1869: George, Clara, Frank, Anna, John, Fred, and Roland. John's father Rufus age over 80. John B Stratton, administrator. Estate included 8 casks containing 100 gallons of wine. Bills from Dr Bantelle and Dr Crosby. Silas H Rhoades bought some land for \$725. John also had land in Winslow known as the bog lot, 35 acres worth \$75. Nancy Rhoades was appointed guardian to Clara E, Frank C, Anna L, John F, Fred L, and Roland E, Feb 28, 1870. John, Fred, and Roland each owned 1/7 of the homestead farm. Nancy sold this 3/7 in 1881 to pay expenses of guardianship.

George Rogers, Historical Society of Litchfield, says 2010 "Thomas Morgridge lived on the Upper Pond Road where I live and where Elder Levi Rhodes lived. Thomas' house currently belongs to Ed Avis, a member of HSOL, and he has done a good job of restoring it. When I was a boy (I'm now seventy-five), the house was a wreck. After years of looking, Ed found the Morgridge cemetery down near the pond. (He had to probe, all the stones were flat and buried and some were broken.) We wondered for years in which church Thomas served as deacon. We eventually found that the Litchfield selectmen divided Litchfield into three religious districts in the early 1800's. Thomas Morgridge and John Brown (Levi Rhodes later purchased the Brown house) were deacons of the East Baptist district. They never did have a church building. My guess would be that Elder Levi Rhodes may have belonged to the Kendall Chapel on the Pond Road but I don't know. He was known for his belief that the world would end soon etc. He reportedly didn't harvest his crops one year because he felt the end was imminent. His daughter, Emma, married into the Small family and I'll check with the Small descendants to see if they know which church Levi attended."

He also adds, I'm the genealogist with the Historical Society of Litchfield. According to the History of Litchfield, written in 1895 by Oliver Barrett Clason, Deacon Thomas Morgridge, an early settler, came to Litchfield from Harpswell. His father, William, reportedly came to Harpswell from England in 1755. Clason's work is usually very good, but I thought that I would check to see if you knew of any connection between your Kittery Morgrage family and the Litchfield Morgridge family. Also, an old farm near the Morgridge homestead was purchased in the early 1900's by my grandfather from Elder Levi Rhoades.

Obituary for Harriet E. Rhoades From: Rensselaer Republican, Thursday, August 9, 1883 (page 4) A Sad Death Mrs. Harriet E. Rhoades, wife of Mr. M. D. Rhoades died at her residence on Front street, in Rensselaer, on Monday morning, August 6th, 1883. The cause of her death was typhoid fever, from which she had been sick for a period of eighteen days. Mrs. Rhoades maiden name was Hudson. She was born in the state of Maryland, on May 22, 1849, and thus dies at the early age of 34 years and a few months. She lived in Rensselaer nearly all her life, and having been left an orphan at an early age she was adopted and raised by her grandfather, William Freeman, a man whom all the old residents of Rensselaer still hold in pleasant remembrance. Her marriage to Marshall D. Rhoades took place October 19th, 1865. Her death is peculiarly sad in that a family of four young children, the youngest of whom is but three years old, suffer the great calamity of losing, in their tender years, the priceless blessing of a devoted mother's care. 1920 Brockton Ward 4, Plymouth Co MA census finds John F Rhoades 56 and Mabel E Rhoades 37 and Evelyn E Rhoades 17, all ME-3. John rents at 1119 Montello St, but is a merchant in fruit store, working on his own account.

1930 Upland census finds John F and Mabel E Rhodes ages 67 and 48, both ME-3, at 1502 E 9th St, proprietor of grocery store, and own home value \$3000. John is not a veteran. Found Mabel in CA 1940-1997 Death index as Mabel C Rhodes b Maine, d 21 Feb 1974 in San Bernardino [possibly the correct Mabel]. Did not find John or Evelyn. John likely died before 1940, and Evelyn likely married. CA Voter Registration lists finds John F Rhoades, grocer 1402 East Ninth St, Upland Precinct 7, San Bernardino Co, registered as a Democrat in 1932, 1934, and as a Merchant 1936 and Nov 1938. Mrs Mabel E Rhoades housekeeper is registered as a Democrat at the same household in 1936 and 1938. In Aug 1940 I don't find John, but Mabel is still at the same address; ditto 1944 and 1946, now Precinct 12. In 1928 John F and Mrs Mabel E Rhoades were storekeepers at 1502 E 9th St, and registered as "declines to state". 1934 finds both as Democrats at 1402 as grocer and storekeeper. Note: there is also a James & Mabel Rhoades in San Bernardino.

Transcript of his obituary in The Pittsfield Advertiser, June 5 1913 . "The death of Roland E Rhoades occurred at 6:15 A.M. Monday at his home on North Main street after an illness of about a week. Mr Rhoades, who was a jeweler, was well known in this section of the state, having been in business at various times in Pittsfield. He was considered something of a genius, and had invented several articles, some of them having been sold for a good sum. He leaves a wife, a small son, a daughter by a former marriage, and one brother, John Rhoades of this town. His age was 45 years. Funeral services were held at his home at 10 o'clock Wednesday forenoon, Rev F.S. Walker officiating. Interment was made at the village cemetery."

Roland and son Ivan are both buried in Pittsfield Village Cemetery, but it appears there is no stone and no record and that the cemetery buried someone else on top of him. Daughter Irma in Pittsfield tried resolving the question with no luck 1950s-1960s. Rev Frederick S Walker was a Universalist minister, at Pittsfield Universalist 1908-1915, and later at Waterville 1925-1928. Roland and his family worked in textile shops in his early years. Roland's first patent for which we find a record was filed Jan 9 1891 when Roland was age 24 and granted Jan 26 1892. It was for an improvement upon the loom.

Roland Eaton Rhoades was named after Roland L Eaton (1835-1870), son of the Rhoades family's good friends, Joseph Eaton (1800-1865) and Mary A (1809-1868). The Eatons are all in Fort Hill Cemetery in Winslow.

1910 Belfast Ward 2 census lists Roland E Rhodes 41 div rents at 71 1/2 High St and is a jeweler, repair work, working on own account. Not found 1900.

Roland is listed in The Maine State Directory & Gazetteer 1893, p 282, and 1894 p 333, and 1895 p311 on Main St in Pittsfield, under Jewelry, Watches, etc. 1898 Worcester MA p411 has a Roland E Rhoades, loomsetter, 123 Tainter, bds. 32 Grand. 1907 Worcester p592 has a Roland E Rhoades, rem'd from city.

Annie Bickford was the dau of Moses Bickford & Helen. Annie L Rhoades divorced Roland E Rhoades for "gross and confirmed habits of intoxication", granted 14 Jan 1899. Damages \$25. Annie m2 Howard Jacobs 24 Dec 1901 Pittsfield.

1902 M/C: Both of Pittsfield. Lillie is the dau of Orine R Soule & Eliza Spaulding, both of/b Palmyra. She m1 Mr Crosby. Lillie is divorced in 1902 age 30, md by J W Webster in Newport. Roland was 35 div jeweler, father b Fairfield, mother b Winslow. 1920 Pittsfield census lists Orin L Soule 77 & Eliza 75. 1900 Palmyra census lists Orin March 1842, Elizabeth Jan 1845 md 26y, 4-3ch, Orin A Crosby grandson Apr 1889. Orin Soule was the son of Rufus, a Mayflower descendant. L Mae Rhoades sued Roland E Rhoades for divorce in Kennebec Co court, for desertion, vol X-p23, granted 29 Sept 1910. Divorce record says they were married 8 Jan 1900, but m/c says 8 June 1902 in Newport. Found no further mar or death rec for Lillie, under any last name.

Family legend, as told by his wife Grace who lived until 1966, says that Roland was friends with Thomas Alva Edison, and that's why his son's middle name is Edison. Roland was a jeweler who worked on clocks. Grace Flagg was a schoolgirl, 27 years younger than him, who walked home past his jeweler's shop in Belfast. They fell in love despite the age difference and got married. Grace also said that he was an alcoholic (also proven in the divorce record of his first wife), and had blinding migraine headaches. A family story passed down is that she being still a girl and not knowing better, as a tidy person, she emptied the little bit of rat poison left over into an old aspirin bottle to make more room. During his headaches, Roland would blindly reach into the medicine cabinet and feel around for the aspirin bottle and mistakenly took the rat poison which killed him. Grace remarried three more times.

During three months of each summer, from 1950-1961, at least eight quality plays or Broadway musicals were staged by the first Maxinkuckee Players, a group of revolving professional and college actors, many of them destined to gain prominence in the world of entertainment.
