Our oldest proven common ancestor is #1 in this report, his children are all numbered. To find the family of any child, browse forward in the report until you come to that child and number's family. Likewise his/her children will be numbered. The report is also sectioned off by Generations. If you don't know your line, start at the end and find yourself and work backwards by the numbers. ## First Generation

**1. William STANIFORD** was born on 26 Mar 1777 in Ipswich, Essex, MA (Possibly) and died after Jun 1860 in Wells, York, ME.

Possibly the William Staniford/Stanford born 26 March 1777 in Ipswich MA to Capt. Jeremiah. He did not m or d in Ipswich. See also 1850 census note below. Name is spelled Stinford on his m/c; all children are spelled Stinnaford on his family register in Wells VR; Stenford or Steneford on his ch d/c. Daughter Eleanor Stinnaford d at age 1.

1850 Wells census York 165 William Staniford 70 born England caulker (boats), Hannah 69 b Wells ME. He died on the poor farm in Wells on Rt 109. 1860 Wells census lists him in the Wells Alms House as William Stinaford 81 pauper b Mass. Wells Hist Soc says there are no marked graves or record of who is buried there. William Stinford m Hannah Cain at the First Church of Wells Congregational, by Rev Moses Hemenway. Family register in Wells VR book p 232.

Various possible parents of Hannah Cain: see Wells VR. Sources besides those stated, ME & MA VR, ME brides/grooms index, ME death index, census, and MOCA cemetery records.

William married **Hannah CAIN** on 9 Dec 1802 in Wells, York, ME. Hannah was born in 1781 in Wells, York, ME and died between 1850 and 1859 in Wells, York, ME.

Nancy married **William Nason HATCH** on 27 Dec 1832 in Wells, York, ME. William was born on 30 Oct 1811 in Wells, York, ME.
- 3 M iv. **William STINEFORD** was born on 15 Jun 1809 in Wells, York, ME and died between 1860 and 1900 in ME.
- F v. **Hannah STINAFORD** was born on 20 Apr 1811 in Wells, York, ME and died in Jul 1851 in Wells, York, ME.

Perkins Cem, Horace Mills Rd, Wells. Walk towards the gravel pit area and take the path to the left up the hill and the small graveyard is on the left. I found and cleaned the lot ca 1990 when I lived just up the road. This is near the intersection of Sanford, Wells, and North Berwick. 1850 Wells census Hannah is 39 in Ann and Bradbury Perkins family. York County Probate File 18061. Hannah Stinaford of Wells. Written May 23, 1851. All property to John B Stevens of Dover NH and Ann M Perkins. Probated Aug 4, 1851 North Berwick. witnesses Joseph Perkins, Hollis Perkins, and ? Perkins. "I William Stinaford the father of Hannah Stinnaford within named, do hereby consent to the allowance of the within instrument ... William Stineford his mark".

- 4 M vi. **John C STENEFORD** was born on 26 Apr 1813 in Wells, York, ME and died between 1841 and 1849 in Wells, York, ME.
- F vii. **Elizabeth STINNAFORD** was born on 15 Jun 1815 in Wells, York, ME.
- 5 M viii. **Nicholas A STINEFORD** was born on 28 Oct 1816 in Wells, York, ME and died on 1 Jan 1890 in Cape Elizabeth, Cumberland, ME.
- M ix. **Samuel STINNAFORD** was born on 12 Nov 1819 in Wells, York, ME and died on 25 Sep 1824 in Wells, York, ME.
- F x. **Eleanor STINNAFORD** was born in 1822 in Wells, York, ME and died on 14 Jun 1823 in Wells, York, ME.

2. **Joseph Cain STINNEFORD** (*William*<sup>1</sup>) was born on 26 Sep 1803 in Wells, York, ME and died before 1840 in Brownville, Piscataquis, ME.

Info from Deeds, Piscataquis Co Courthouse 7/28/2010.

Dec 6, 1831, entered June 9, 1832. Vol R p105 (from Pen v31p110): Warranty deed, Moses Greenleaf of Williamsburgh sells for \$50 to Joseph C Stinniford of Williamsburgh Yeoman, the easterly half part of lot70 acc to the survey and plan of Eben Greenleaf and bounded as follows, viz, beginning at the SE corner of said lot being also the NE corner of Peter Perham's land, thence running west by said Perham's land 120 rods to the westerly half of said lot on the Crosby lot, so called, now in possession of Isaac Stevens, thence north by said Crosby lot 66 2/3 rods to the NE corner thereof thence east parallel to the first described line 120 rods to the NE corner of said lot 70, thence south 66 2/3 rods to the first bound - containing 50 acres more or less. Signed in presence of Eben Greenleaf, JP.

Same dates, p106 (Pen p 111): Joseph mortgaged said land to Moses Greenleaf for \$50 for 10 years. Oct 12, 1833 - Received of Benjamin P Gilman the amount due on the mortgage; entered April 29, 1834.

Same dates, p 107 (Pen p 112): Joseph mortgaged to Moses Greenleaf for \$200 for 3 years.

Vol R p 281: Joseph C Stinniford of Brownville for \$20 pd by Benjamin P Gilman of Sebec, Merchant, quitclaimed this land in Williamsburg. Deed description, Crosby/Stevens lot now in possession of Benj P Gilman.

Only Joseph Stinneford deeds found. No Stinneford deeds 1838-1847 either. See Deeds for son George H.

Joseph married **Phebia RUSSEL** about 1822. Phebia was born in 1803 in Litchfield, Kennebec, ME and died after 1880 in Dover, Piscataquis, ME.

1880 Dover, Piscataquis, ME Census 108/111: Phebe Cosen, mother, age 73 ME-3, living in household of Oliver Stinneford. Cannot find the Cosen name anywhere in census indexes except for this 1880 mention. There is a Cousens family in MOCA's "Old Cemetery" in Abbott. Cousens is a big family in York County and Wells. Phebe Cousens not found in 1860 census or 1870. Just plain Phebe in Piscataquis Co does not find this Phebe either. No Phebe Russell in Wells VR book. She would have married him probably after 1840 and he would have died before 1880.

Litchfield VR book p66: Died May the 22nd day AD 1805 Rachel Russell wife to Daniel Russell the doctor. Also p422. Perhaps this indicates the parents of Phebia. ??

Died May 31 1805 Polly Russell daughter to Daniel Russell & Rachel his wife aged [blank]. Also p422.

p88 George G Russel & Eleanor Power both of Bowdoin, md 6 Apr 1809.

p164 Hermon Russell & Ann Lowell both of L, marr int 10 May 1823.

p171 Harrison Berstow Russell b 8 Apr 1824 to Harrison & Ann. [sic?]

p302 Harmon B Russell b 8 Apr 1824 to Harmon & Ann.

1790 census: No Russel in Litchfield (then Smithtown Plt, Lincoln).

1800 Litchfield census pop 1044: none on Ancestry index Russel or Russell or Reusel

1810 Litchfield census pop 1847: none on Ancestry index

1820 Litchfield census pop 2120: none on Ancestry index.

Possible Russel cousins in Dover VR: trace them to see if they go back to Litchfield.

LOTS of them in index.

Hancock Co Marriage Returns lists William Stineford and Ruth Page, both of Bucksport, m 30 Mar 1831 Bluehill. I list it here as a possibility, but it is likely a whole different family; 1830 Bucksport census shows a William Staniford of wrong age for this family (age 50-60, wife 30-40). Child of WILLIAM STINEFORD and RUTH PAGE is: i. WILLIAM E STENIFORD, b. Sep 1832; m. MARY A SHERMAN, 1860. Notes for WILLIAM E STENIFORD: 1900 Bangor census p 126 5 Ohio St (and only Steniford in census index) William E Steniford 67 Sep 1832 sailmaker rent ME-MA-ME; Mary A 62 Sept 1838 M40 1-1 ME-MA-MA; Josephine H 22 Dec 1877; Harriet H Sherman 83 July 1816 mother-in-law MA-ME-ME. Try to find his d/c for parents. 6/6/08: Nothing in VR for Sten\_\_ spelling; all under Stinneford and nothing found.

William's 1809 Birthdate is from Wells VR, though it does not exactly match census records: 1850 Guilford: William Stinneford 36, Susan 36, Madina 7 [must be Madison], Lucretia 5, Amos 3, Benjamin Edes 74 b MA, Abigail Edes 75 b MA, Mary Edes 47. 1860 Williamsburg 254/258: William Stinneford 46 farmer, Susan [Edes] 45, Madison 16, Lucretia 15, Joseph K 9, Benjamin Edes 83 [1777] MA, Abbey Edes 85 [1775]. Amos is in 1860 Sebec as 14 in David Shephard family 11/11. Note that brother Joseph had also gone to Williamsburg.

This is a letter from Charles Hammond Stineford to a Gus Stineford dated 12-20-1985 My great grandfather was a seaman on a British ship that was patrolling the coast of Maine during the war of 1812. He jumped ship(which makes us all wetbacks)and fled to the northern part of Maine near Mt. Katadin. He married an indian squaw of the Abanaki tribe and spent the rest of his life in Maine. I do not know how many children he had, but my grandfather [Joseph K] was born in Brownville, Me. He sired 8 chidren according to my father but I only remember 6 names-Joseph,Joshua,Ora,Charles,Annie,and Clara. He died at the age of 92.

William married **Susan EDES**, daughter of **Benjamin EDES** and **Abigail**, about 1840. Susan was born in 1815 in Guilford, Piscataquis, ME and died after 1860.

Wells VR p 304: John C Steniford and Mary Jane Taylor both of Wells mar int 3 July 1836. p 339: Mr John Steneford and Miss Mary June Taylor both of Wells, mar 24 June 183\_ [1837 by Elder Joseph Goodwin]. 1850 Wells census York 163 Mary Jane Staniford 33, Oliver H 9, both b Wells, in Dimond Taylor (age 58 b Wells) family.

John married **Mary Jane TAYLOR** on 24 Jun 1837 in Wells, York, ME. Mary was born in 1817 in Wells, York, ME and died after 1850.

Cemetery lot Saco rear of Beach St. Benjamin Goodale of Saco, Exec. 1850 Saco census York 301. Nicholas Stinneford 28 laborer, Caroline 22, Henry 3, all b ME 1860 Saco p96 686/684 Nicholas Stenneford 37 laborer, Caroline 31, Henry 13, ?Lillian A 10 1870 Saco p 577 630/705 Nicholas Steneford 47 watchman \$200/\$100, Caroline 41, Willie A 9 1880 Saco North St Nicholas Stinneford 57 laborer, Caroline 51, William A 19. Cape Eliz records death as 1 Dec 1883.

Nicholas married **Caroline A PATTERSON** on 9 Nov 1846 in Saco, York, ME. Caroline was born about 1828 and died on 1 Dec 1887 in Saco, York, ME.

York Co Divorce record gives her name and marriage date, v31 p261. Married Georgia Knox, both of Saco, by Rev Charles Webber. He was always a chaste, faithful and affectionate husband, but she on about Nov 12 1872 deserted and committed adultery with lewd men. Filed for divorce Apr 30 1874. She did not appear in court. Divorce decreed May 29 1874.  
Henry married **Georgia KNOX** on 4 Nov 1872 in Saco, York, ME.

6. **George H STINNEFORD** (*Joseph Cain*<sup>2</sup>, *William*<sup>1</sup>) was born between 1822 and 1826 in Dover, Piscataquis, ME and died on 10 Oct 1887 in Dover, Piscataquis, ME.

George's birthplace is in doubt; I don't believe they were in Dover this early. See deeds for Joseph and George. Piscataquis Observer has these two marriage notices that I had not come across before 6/21/2009: George H. Stineford of Dover to Data A. Spaulding of Dover, published in the paper August 5, 1852, married in Foxcroft by Rev. W. W. Wilson on the 1st Inst. (Aug. 1) 1852. Lydia H. Stineford married Aaron T. Wark in Dover, published December 11, 1856, on the 9th by A.K. P. Gray, Esq. Appears Lydia may be a previously unknown sister of George.

1850 census: George is a laborer in Charleston, Pen Co; not indexed by Ancestry. 1860: not indexed in Wellington, Brighton, or Harmony.

1860 Harmony Mortality census says baby George died Jan 1860 of dropsy on the brain [30 hrs]. Baby George, Ellen V, and Marcus are buried in Hutchins Corner Cemetery in Wellington. Ancestry's copy of the federal copy of the census was mis-transcribed; page 59 427/449 has George H Stinchfield 33 farmer \$300RE/230PE, Lupira Stinchfield 27, Ella Y 3, Ellura 1/12, enumerated 9 July 1860 by Caleb Leavitt. Next door is Joseph 24 & Loantha Trafton 18. Brother Oliver Stinneford is same page 433/455.

10 July 1860 Harmony Agricultural census p19 Line 9: 20 acres improved, 60 not; value \$300, tools \$10. 3 milch cows, 2 working oxen, 7 sheep Value \$140. 7 bushels Indian corn, 10 bushels oats, 21 lbs wool, 1 bushel peas and beans, 35 bushels Irish potatoes, 75 lbs butter, 15 tons hay. Value of homemade manufactures \$15. Value of animals slaughtered \$31.

1870 Brighton p 64-5 101/102: George H Stinneford 43 farmer \$800RE/\$350PE, Lupira 38, Ellen B 13, Ellura M 10, Alwilda 8, Laforest L 6, Eddy W 3, Mary E 1

1880 Brighton p28, 223/235: George H Stinneford 58, Lupira B 48, Alwilda M 18, Laforest L 16, Wallace E 14, Mary E 10, Ella V 9, Achsah J 7, Roland E 4. All b ME-ME-ME.

17 June 1880 Brighton agricultural census p22 line 7: George H Stinneford owner. 25 acres tilled, 20 acres pasture/meadow, 45 acres woodland. Farm value \$500, implements \$20, livestock \$100. Cost of building and repairing in 1879 \$10. Est value of 1879 farm production \$125. 20 acres mown, 20 not, 12 hay, 1 horse.

Piscataquis County marriage returns v3 p286: George H Stineford of Dover & Miss Eliza E Tozier of Garland m 4 June 1887 in Garland by a J.P. Mrs Eliza Stinneford of Dover South Mills md George L Smith in Dexter 30 May 1891 - Dexter VR p27. A George Smith d Dexter 19 Apr 1896 age 80. Dover VR v1 p639 has mar int of George H Stineford of Dover & Miss Eliza E Tozier of Garland 28 May 1887; p641 says George H Stineford md Mrs Eliza E Tozier of Garland 4 June 1887 at Garland by Edwin Hill JP. No Tozier in 1880 Garland census.

Deeds:

Piscataquis Co Vol 26 p 152-154: May 22, 1852, recorded May 24: James (& Hannah H) Thompson of Dover sold for \$250 to George H Stinneford of Dover 25 acres, from the NE corner of lot 2 in the tenth range of lots, bounded as follows, beginning at NW corner of said lot thence south on the west line of said lot to the center of a spring a few rods easterly of the dwelling house of Robt Rogers, thence east so far that a line running north and parallel with the east line to the north line, thence west on the north line to the first named corner. George then mortgaged it back to him for \$200 same day for 4 years. Mortgage paid off May 8, 1856.

George H Stinneford of Dover bought land in Harmony 1854 on Wellington town line 78-207, 81-334.

Thelma Barrows wrote in 1985 "According to my grandmother [Ella], she and her brothers and sisters had a hard life growing up. They each were assigned jobs to do each week and had to do them. Uncle Roland was 7 when his mother died so the older ones took care of the younger. George left the family and married again. According to my mother he went to Dover ME and is buried there. Grammy never talked much about her family. I knew all of them but Laforest. I knew Alwilda, Achsah, Ellura and Roland when I lived in Waterville. When I moved to Guilford at age 9, I got to know Mary and family real well in Greenville and used to go up there to visit. Wallace came across from Wellington. Harold Bean gave me much of the family tree and takes care of the Hutchins cemetery as he is also descended from George and Jane Trafton."

George married **Data 'Daty' Ann SPAULDING**, daughter of **Artemus SPAULDING** and **Mary DENNETT**, on 1 Aug 1852 in Foxcroft, Piscataquis, ME. Data was born in 1833 in Dover, Piscataquis, ME.

Penobscot Co Marriage Returns: Henry J White & Daty Ann Stinifred both of Bangor md 17 Apr 1858 Bangor. 1860 Bangor census has Henry White 26 mariner b VA, Data White 26 ME, Asher Spaulding 17 mariner ME. Asher Spaulding's d/c: d Aug 12 1909 Boston age 69,5,25 wd, b Dover ME to Artemus Spaulding b Norridgewock & Mary Dennett b Lyman. Bangor births lists one child to this couple, Charles Henry White b 13 May 1861. Found no divorce record between George Stinneford & Daty.

George next married **Lupira B Maria TRAFTON**, daughter of **George Riley TRAFTON** and **Margaret Jane PENNEY**, about 1855. Lupira was born on 21 Feb 1832 in Wellington, Piscataquis, ME and died on 11 Apr 1883 in Brighton, Somerset, ME.

Hutchins Corner Cem, Wellington says Mother/ Lupira B/ wife of/ George H Stinneford/ Died/ Apr 11, 1883/ AE 51yrs 1mo 20ds/ She has reached the haven of the blest,/ And reached immortal joy.

Brighton Plantation is a plantation in Somerset County, incorporated as the town of North Hill on June 20, 1816 from the township T2 R1 BKP. It changed its name to Brighton on January 29, 1827. The town ceded land to Athens in 1838 and again in 1862. In 1895 Brighton surrendered its organization as a town and reemerged with a simpler structure as a plantation. 2008 population is 86. The community is north of Athens on Route 151 at the junction with Route 154. From Maine: An Encyclopedia ([www.themaineencyclopedia.com](http://www.themaineencyclopedia.com)) Wellington is a town in Piscataquis County, settled in 1814 and incorporated on February 23, 1828 from the township T3 R1 BKP, WKR. In 1885 it ceded some land to the Somerset County town of Cambridge. Named for the Duke of Wellington who defeated Napoleon at Waterloo in 1815, this small town has a history of lumbering and farming. The community is northwest of Harmony on the Wellington Road, also Maine Route 154. 2008 population 258. We have a signature of "Mr & Mrs J F Partridge" in Edith Leavitt's Marriage Guest Book. No children. July 1941 letter from William Robertson to Marguerite: "Aunt Alwilda is still at Byfield [MA] with the Partridges and from letters received gather that she is failing slowly. They took her to Boston one day (about 15 miles) and she had to rest up there and go to bed when she got home so can't stand much of a ride anymore." He also mentioned taking care of cemeteries in Waterville and Winslow. Muriel Robertson Rhoades recalls: "I don't know about Uncle Frank. Aunt Alwilda, Martha and I called her Aunt Widow, as we couldn't pronounce her real name. Dad would take us to visit when we were real little. She had an apple orchard and would scrape apple juice for us to eat. We also climbed in the trees." James Frank Partridge d/c: he died at the Belfast Hospital, there 2 days, res Northport; chronic myocarditis, bur Winslow, inf William Robertson. His parents were William T Partridge b c Nov 1830 Vassalboro & Lucinda F Witham b c Nov 1820 Smithfield, who mar in 1859 [d/c and 1900 census]. Wm T Partridge is buried at Fort Hill Cemetery, Winslow. There is a Partridge monument near the entrance to the right. James and Alwilda may possibly also be buried there. William Robertson wrote in a 1941 letter about taking care of the family cemetery plots in Winslow. Achsah Stinneford Thompson is in the same lot area.  
Alwilda married **James Frank PARTRIDGE** on 12 Jun 1900 in Waterville, Kennebec, ME. James was born on 16 Mar 1860 in Winslow, Kennebec, ME and died on 7 May 1939 in Belfast, Waldo, ME.
- M v. **Laforest Lowell STINNEFORD** was born in Apr 1864 in Brighton, Somerset, ME and died on 28 Mar 1925 in Corinna, Penobscot, ME.

A short time since I called upon a family living at Dover South Mills by the name of Stinneford. Mr & Mrs S. have had a family of some half a dozen children, of whom all but two have grown to maturity and some now have families of their own. Of these two the youngest, now eight years old, is a natural curiosity, for he was born without eyes. He has eyebrows & eyelids, but there is nothing which indicates the presence of eye-balls, or anything in the nature of eye-balls. Doctors who have seen this boy say that he has nothing whatever in the nature of an eye organism. There are slight openings

between the lids, but they are apparently not more than a quarter - and perhaps not more than an eighth as long as they would be for the natural eyes. The little fellow is perfect in every other respect and is an unusually bright boy. He has a very correct musical ear, and also shows an aptitude for declamation unusual for one of his age. He has never been heard to utter a word of complaint at his condition, and he invariably rebukes his friends if they give expression to any pitying words. He seems to realize, however, that it is a calamity to be blind, as the following incident will show: his little niece had a cataract upon her eye, and he had heard fears expressed lest it should destroy her sight. It was not long after this that his mother heard his voice in an adjoining room, and going quietly to the door she listened; what was her surprise when she heard him praying to God that the little baby might not become blind! His parents tell some almost incredible stories about this boy. They say that when he was only seven months old he would "hum" a perfect tune as he lay in his cradle, and they told me its name but I cannot just now recall it. It was one of those old pennyroyal hymns that somebody had sung in the house. The boy sings a good many songs that he has committed to memory, and also speaks, with considerable elocutionary skill, a number of pieces, both in prose and verse. He is a good speller, being farther advanced in this branch than many boys who have had the advantage of schools, and are two or three years older. He disposes of such words as "Constantinople", "Massachusetts", etc., without any apparent difficulty. His sense of touch is very acute, readily recognizing the value of any coin that is given him. And I will here remark that is a very proper thing for visitors to substantially remember the little unfortunate when they go in to see him and not depart without leaving something for his benefit or amusement. His folks told me that he has never heard a piano or any organ, and that, with the exception of an accordeon and squeaky fiddle, he had never heard the sound of any kind of musical instrument. When listening to music, even the poor grade that he has heard, he seems to be almost in ecstasy, and it is hoped that something will be done so that he may receive such an education as his natural capacity seems to call for. The boy's name is Charles Stinneford. I think his father's first name is Oliver. I will here say that these people treated me very politely when I called. They are not burdened with this world's goods, but they know what constitutes good manners and that is more than can be said of some who have wealth. They say that they are pleased to have any one come in, who has a curiosity to see the blind boy. D/C says he is blind, age 47, died of pneumonia, broncho, and influenza; buried Dover South Mills Cem.

Age is 74,9,28, [=April 21, 1837] which is off one year from the Apr 1836 from the 1900 census. Mary was more likely to be correct in 1900 than a next-of-kin in 1912. One World Tree gives 19 Apr 1834 Brownville (next door to Milo); I think 1836 is more likely. Marriage int are also rec in Piscataquis Co Marriage returns CD p324, as Miss Mary E Stinneford of Sebec & Mr Aaron W Edgerly of Dover 15 May 1854. Sebec is between Brownville and Dover. Also in Dover VR v1 p469, married by Moses Ames, Minister of the Gospel.

Joseph is always referred to as simply Joseph C, the middle name lost to history. The C could stand for Clifford or Calvin or Clinton, maybe it was just plain C, so it could stand for any of them; see notes under his father. None of the names is carried on in subsequent generations. I believe his full name is most likely Joseph Calvin, named after both of his parents' fathers. The entire family of Joseph, Ellura, Sina, Chester, Ulrich, Edith and husband William are all buried in the family plot at Pine Grove Cemetery in Waterville, Lot 548. Have photos of stones, and photos of people except Chester and Ulrich. November 2008, Pine Grove Cemetery told us their records state that Chester was reinterred in 1903 from Cambridge Maine. They also said that Ulrich Leavitt is buried there in "plot #4", though without any marker. No living family members had known anything about it. Joseph C Leavitt is also registered as the person who bought the lot in Mt Pleasant Cemetery in Cambridge, where his father Ralph is buried, and likely where his son Chester was buried.

Death certificate says he committed "suicide by drowning", jumping off a bridge in Auburn. He was reportedly in great pain from some illness.

It is quite obvious that they did little research inasmuch as Lawrence C. (Larry) is my son and has lived in Montana for 10 years. (now lives in Ca. B.E.S.) I've lived at this adress for 15 years and they do not list me. Probably because I have an unlisted phone. ( adress at this time was 81763 Drawbridge Ave Indio, Ca. 92201) Now that I have that off my chest I will give

you what scoop I have on my branch of the Stinefords. It is not a common surname so I feel that we have a common ancestor. My great grandfather was a seaman on a British ship that was patrolling the coast of Maine during the war of 1812. He jumped ship(which makes us all wetbacks)and fled to the northern part of Maine near Mt. Katadin. he married an indian squaw of the Abanaki tribe and spent the rest of his life in Maine. I do not know how many children he had but my grandfather was born in Brownsville,Me. He sired 8 children according to my father but I only remember 6 names-Joseph,joshua,Ora,Charles,Annie,and Clara.
